DG EAC RECENT ACTIVITIES

- ❖1. Publication of the Ethical Guidelines on the use of AI and data in teaching and learning for educators (26 October 2022)
- ❖2. Organisation, hosting or presentation in 28 dissemination and awareness-raising events on the use of AI in education (October 2022-present)
- ❖3. Publication of 9 articles, news items, press releases and interviews on AI in education (October 2022-present)
- ❖4. Update of the Digital Competences Framework for citizens, to include AI and data, among other emerging technologies (March 2022)



DG EAC FUTURE ACTIVITIES

- ❖5. **Upcoming research studies, in collaboration with JRC, on AI in education (decision pending)**
- ❖6. **Upcoming teacher training course on AI in education (decision pending)**

To monitor the achievement of policy objectives

To encourage evidence-based policy making

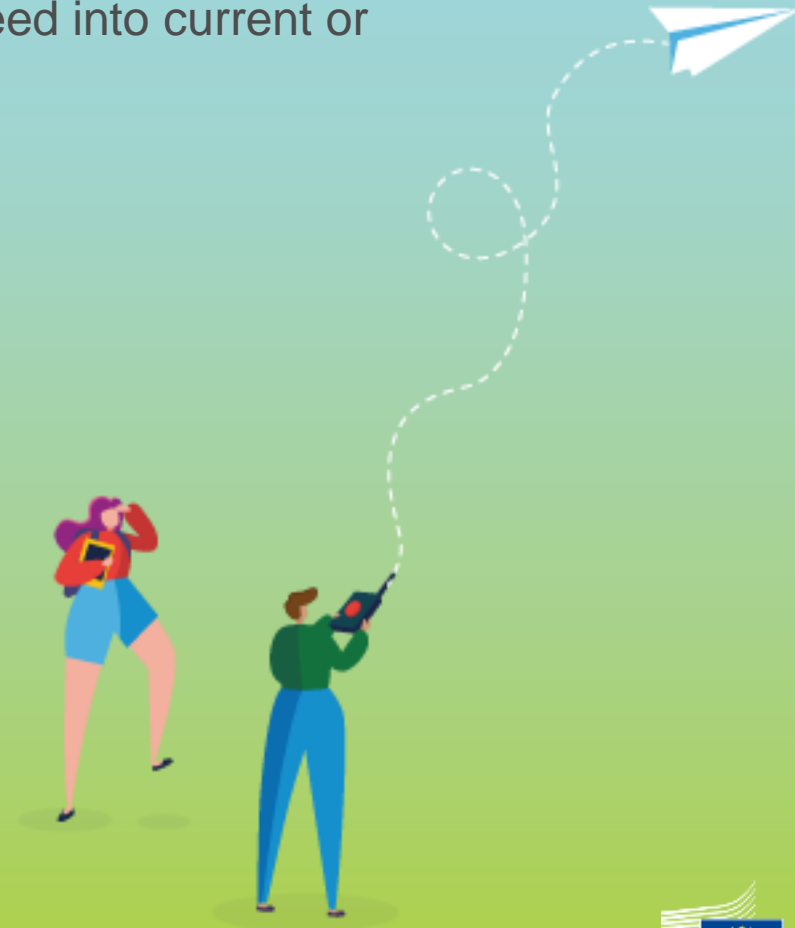
To fine-tune policy, where necessary

You promote your own project



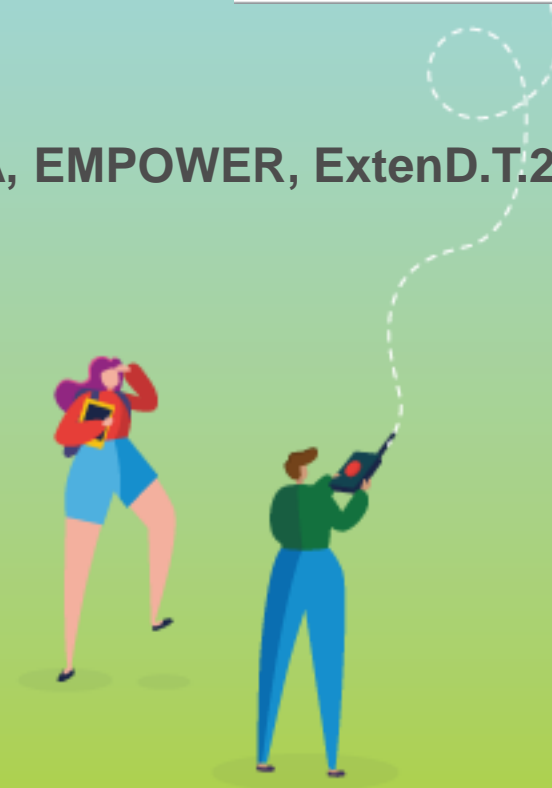
Policy Brief

❖ Type of policy feedback activities

- Policy brief as a mandatory deliverable
- Ad hoc requests e.g. for monitoring purposes
- Partake in **cluster events**
- **Clustering of projects AugMENTOR, e-DIPLOMA, EMPOWER, ExtenD.T.2 and i-MASTER**

❖ 4 key aspects to be addressed:

- Project objectives and methodology
- **Evidence** and Analysis
- Policy implications and recommendations
- Sustainability and legacy after end of your projects
