Airlink Express bus services from in-front of the airport will bring you direct to the College Green in front of the main TCD campus.

Hotels in Dublin are expensive so you may want to consider hostels which have private rooms or AirBnB.

There is a <u>Generator Hostel</u> in Smithfield that is located on the Luas so handy to get to TCD. Your stop would be the Convention Centre then cross the river. This hostel also has a good supermarket, cinema and great traditional irish music pub all on the same square.
